



**FABRICS**

Large selection of natural colors and cooling shades as listed in the catalogue, including:

- light-dimming fabrics
- fabrics layered with microscopic aluminum for reducing heat from incoming sunlight
- fabrics layered with microscopic pearls for reducing condensation

Pleated fabrics of various types and material makeup differ in RAT value (reflection, absorption, transmission). Thinner pleated fabrics allow more light penetration than thicker fabrics.

Two-fabric combination.



**HEAD RAIL / BOTTOM RAIL**

The head rail and bottom rail are made from anodized aluminum and come in white or silver. Both rails may be set either tight or loose enabling Plissé blinds to be raised or lowered to the desired height from either top or bottom positions.

**MOUNTING**

Plissé is assembled with clips (brackets) onto the window's moulding, frame or jamb. The head rail is screwed into clips (brackets). Plissé blinds are drawn and then the bottom rail is snapped in and the strainers are attached.

*Recommendation: Optimal window moulding depth is min.25 mm!*

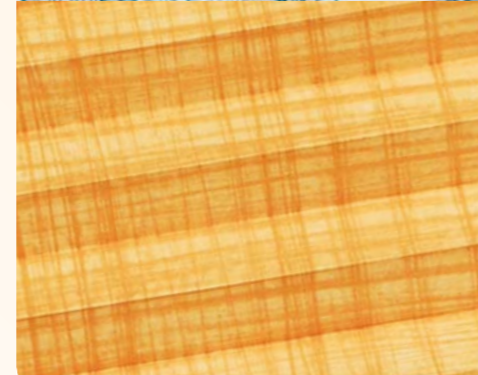

- *Plissé in trapezoid, triangle, or arched shapes*
- *Plissé for angled skylights and horizontal ceiling windows*
- *Plissé for winter gardens*

### DESIGN OPTIONS

**Free-hanging plissé** with various modes of operation (cord, handpull) and mounting options

- for right-angled windows
- for window mantels



**Plissé with side guiding** by rope or string with several options of manipulation (cord, handpull, motor) and mounting

- for skylights
- for horizontal ceiling windows
- for winter gardens

*Note: Plissé with string guiding for swivel windows allows for a max.window angle of 15°. String guided plissé is recommended for window angles greater than 70°.*

### OPERATION



#### Manual operation:

-  - plastic handpull
-  - cord with built-in brake

*Note: with Plissé products featuring two fabrics, each fabric has its own cord.*



#### Electric operation (24V):

-  - electric switch
-  - remote control
